

Induction of 1999 Honorees

1999 Inductees

Charles Childress*

Mules' Basketball/Track & Field - 1929-33

He led the basketball team in scoring and earned All-MIAA honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. He won the decathlon at the 1933 Kansas Relays. From 1937-68, he served as coach, athletics director and administrator at Lee's Summit. In 1945-46, he coached the football team to an unbeaten season, saw his basketball team lose just one game and coached the track team to indoor and outdoor state championships.

Mark Burrell

Mules' Wrestling - 1988-90

He is the first Mules' wrestler to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. He won back-to-back NCAA championships at 126 pounds, becoming the first CMSU athlete to win two individual national titles. His 1988-89 record was 44-6-2 and his 1989-90 record was 40-3-1. He still owns six CMSU records and ranks fourth in career wins with a record of 84-9-3,

Jackie Harris

Jennies' Basketball - 1982-86

She was a member of the Jennies' 1984 national championship team. As a senior in 1986, she was a 1st-team All-American and co-MIAA MVP when she averaged 21.8 points. She is one of only three Jennies' players to score 40 points in a game. Her 631 points in 1986 rank as the third-best season total in Jennies' history. She ranks ninth on the Jennies' career scoring list with 1,417 points and sixth in career games played with 120.

Sittichoke Huckuntod

Mules' Baseball - 1988-90

He led the Mules to three MIAA titles and three NCAA tournament bids. He was a two-time first-team All-American and in 1990 also was College Division Academic All-American of the Year for baseball. His 1990 record of 104 hits in a season remains a CMSU & MIAA record, as well as his career stolen base record of 121. His career average of .403 is second-best in Mules' history.

James Kirkpatrick*

Distinguished Service

He was a member of CMSU's Board of Regents for 12 years, 10 as president. He was instrumental in making improvements at Vernon Kennedy Field during his tenure. He was an original member of the Hall of Fame selection committee and served as chairman of the committee until his death in 1997.

The Mules were 8-3, one of only four Mules' football teams to win eight games, and won the Shrine Bowl over Pittsburg State 32-21, becoming the only Mules' football team to win a bowl game.
